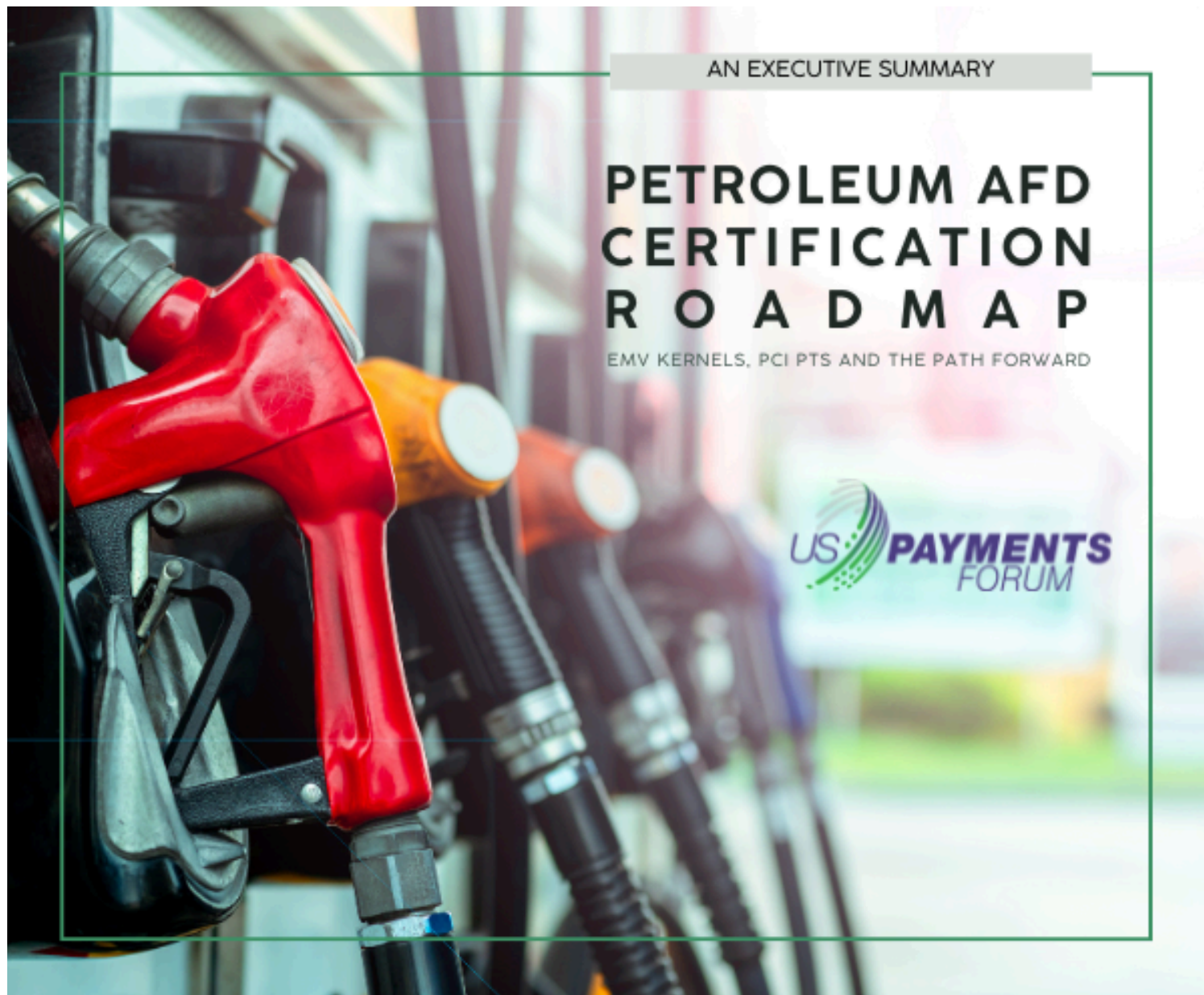
Announcing the 2026 U.S. Payments Forum Steering Committee

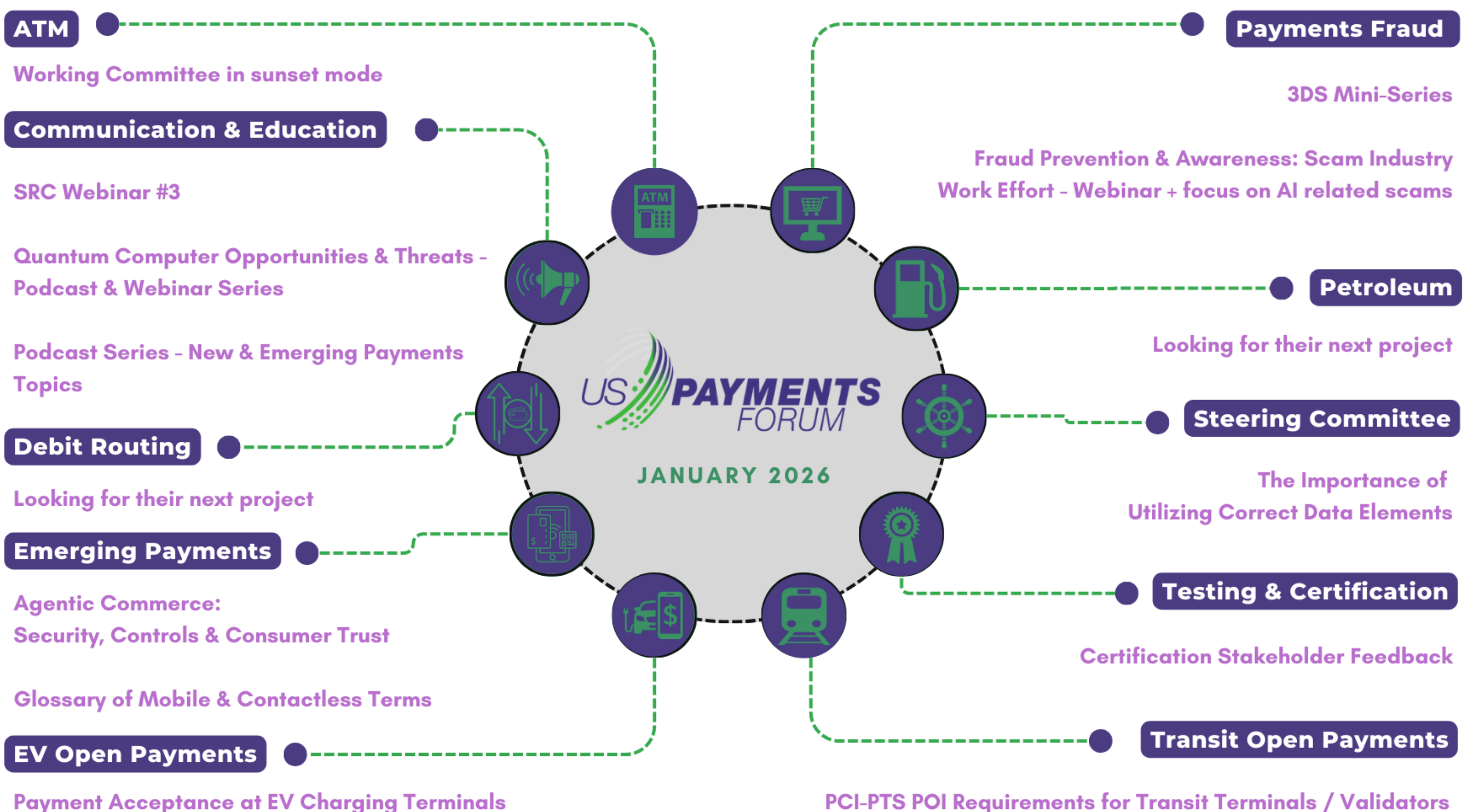

As certification expiration timelines progress—with one milestone recently passed and another approaching—the resource outlines industry impacts, certification dependencies, and key planning considerations to support informed decision-making. Developed by the Forum’s Petroleum Working Committee, the publication provides timely context for petroleum merchants and industry stakeholders navigating this evolving landscape.

Purpose of the Summit

The Deepfake Summit is an executive forum addressing one of the most urgent, and disruptive forces shaping modern payments and identity ecosystems: AI-generated deepfakes and synthetic identities.

These emerging threats challenge every assumption about secure onboarding, authentication, fraud mitigation, and trust. As financial services, fintech, and payments providers accelerate toward frictionless digital experiences, the risk surface expands dramatically.
